Charitable Giving Committee 2017-2018 Annual Report

This was an active year for the members of the charitable giving committee and the women of the Woman's Club. We supported many community programs, both through volunteer work and through monetary and in-kind donations.

MONETARY DONATIONS

Welbourne Avenue Nursery and Kindergarten	- \$2,000.00
Central Florida Vocal Arts	- \$600.00
Dress for Success	- \$600.00
Adult Literacy League	- \$600.00
Family Promise of Greater Orlando	- \$1,100.00
Neighbors Network	- \$300.00
A Gift for Teaching	- \$200.00
Poodle and Pooch Rescue of Florida	- \$200.00

This totals \$5,600.00, the amount the finance committee authorized us to allocate. Another \$1500.00 was given to the Welbourne Avenue Nursery and Kindergarten during the holidays by individual members' contributions. In addition, this Spring, another member gave \$1,000.00 to the nursery as start-up monies for the children to grow a vegetable garden.

Additional monies that we have accrued through our fundraisers are being held to eventually fund a major project.

IN-KIND DONATIONS

After Hurricane Irma, the women of the club contributed canned goods and other products to both the Orlando Union Rescue Mission and the Winter Park Housing Authority to assist in replenishing items after the hurricane. Total value was \$400.00, approximately \$200.00 for each program. Salvation Army Christmas stockings - 60 stockings at a value of \$35.00 each - \$2,100.00

Winter Park Housing Authority Christmas Families at the Meadows – 4 families with a total of 11 children. Each mother received a 50.00 gift card from Walmart. The children each received gifts totaling an average of \$125.00/child. Total for both mothers and children - \$1570.00

Winter Park Housing Authority Valentine's Day party at the Meadows for 50 children – cookies, candies, valentine cards, balloons, paper products - \$150.00

Orlando Union Rescue Mission Purple Bags at Easter -28 bags at \$30.00/bag - \$840.00. We also donated 11 pairs of new sneakers - \$30.00 each pair - \$330.00.

Family Promise – We donated start up kits throughout the year – \$352.47 Dress for Success – we donated good quality clothing and accessories, valued at \$3,200.00

MONETARY DONATIONS – \$5,600.00 (Does not include the \$2,500.00 that individuals gave to Welbourne Avenue Nursery and Kindergarten during the holidays, through the charitable giving committee.)

IN-KIND DONATIONS - \$8,842.47

TOTAL - \$14,442.41

In addition, our committee member, Sandra Blossey, wrote a grant to the St. Margaret Mary Catholic Church Outreach Fund to support Welbourne Avenue Nursery and Kindergarten in their efforts to expand their Welbourne Kinder Gardeners vegetable garden. Welbourne received \$3,500.00 from the fund. This will be an ongoing project for Welbourne and one that our committee will be involved in for oversight.
