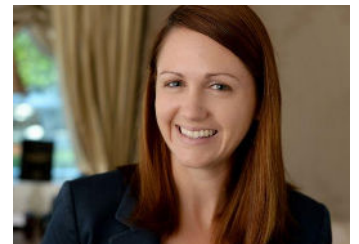


### **Thursday, January 17<sup>th</sup>, 2019, 6PM: Founder's Day Reception & Dinner**

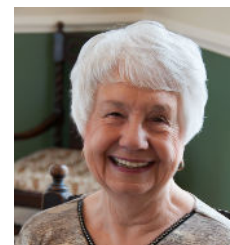

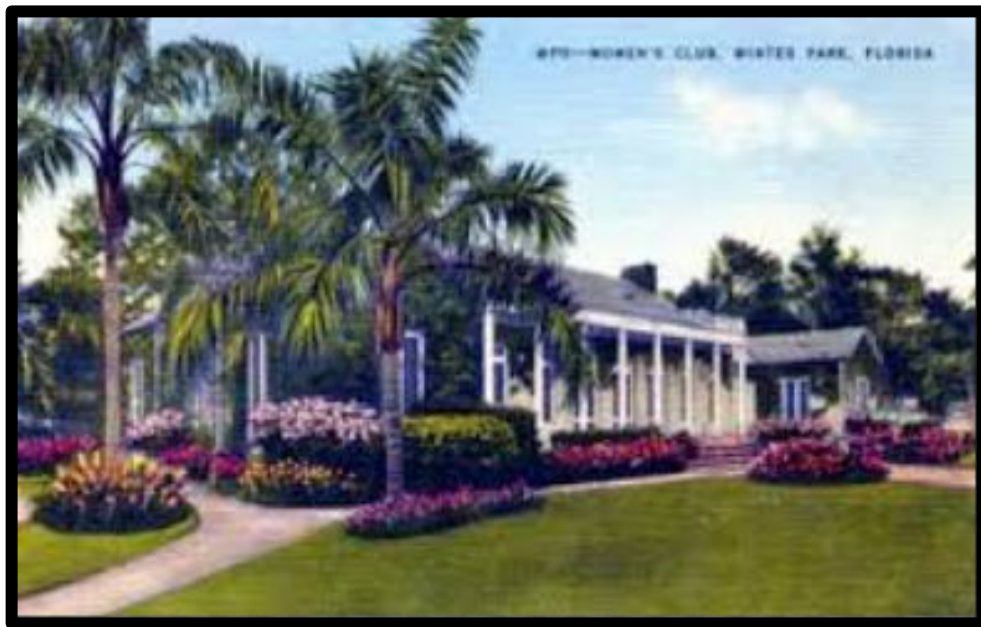
