Missing years: 1915, 1916, 1923, 1924, 1925, 1927, 1932, 1933, 1934, 1935, 1937, 1938, 1939, 1940, 1942, 1943 and 1946. In 1932, bulletins were substituted for Membership Yearbooks, so anything from those

years might look very different from what we have today. In 1941, Membership Yearbooks were again created.

The Archival Collection is also missing a 2014 - 2015 Membership Yearbook. The archives will even take yearbooks with your hand written name and/or notes in them, which actually makes them more fun!

Also, on Wednesday, September 14, from 11:00 am - 12:00 pm, as Club Historian, I will be joining well-known Winter Park Historian Fairlyn Livingston at the Winter Park Public Library to explore the history of West Winter Park and the story of two Winter Park club members: Mrs. Mary Lee DePugh, a founder of the Ideal Woman's Club, and Mrs. Maud Kraft, an early Woman's Club of Winter Park club member. 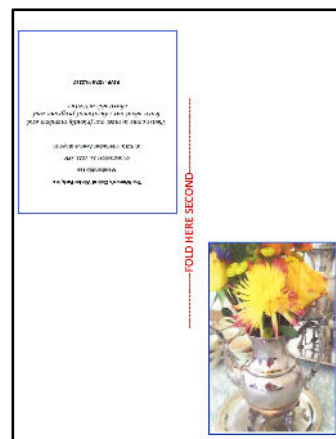
